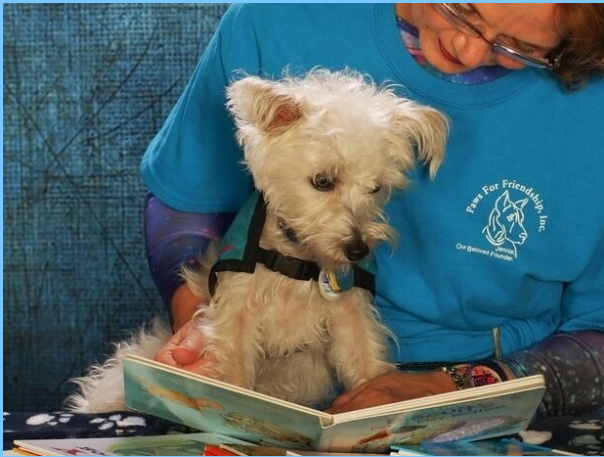

#CodeClarinda saw many children and even some adults log 30 hours of learning about STEM concepts.



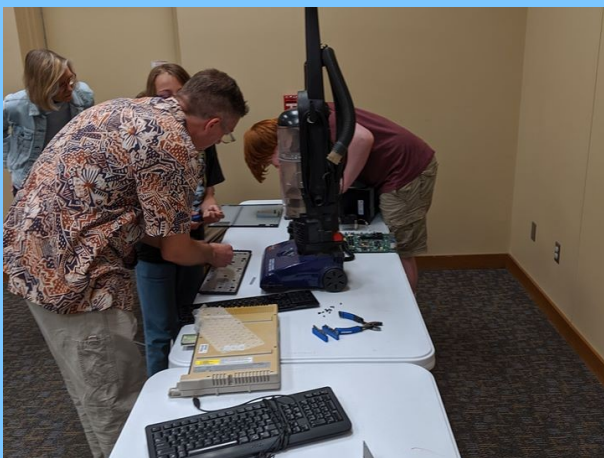
Standing room only for this POW Program with Chad Timm was one of many programs at the library.

A Family STEM night allowed participants to hack into various pieces of electronics

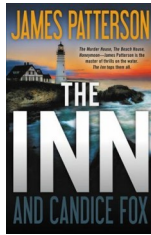

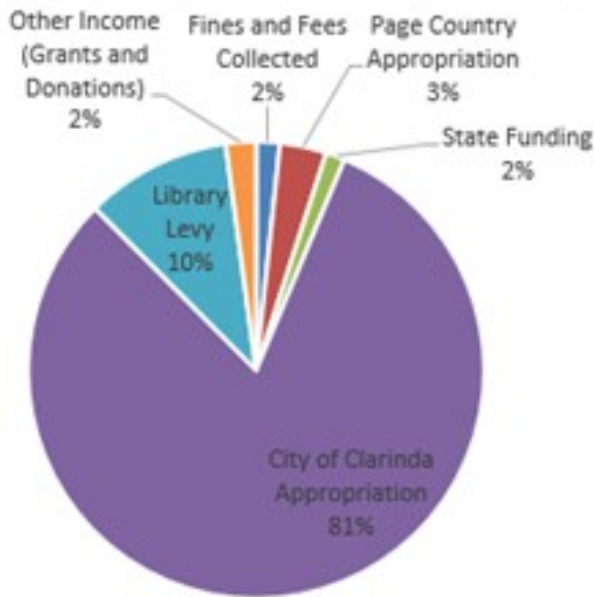
Revenues and Expenditures (Fiscal Year 2019)

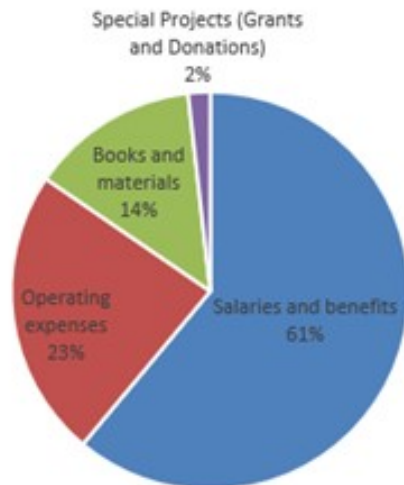
Fines and Fees Collected (2%)	\$5,569

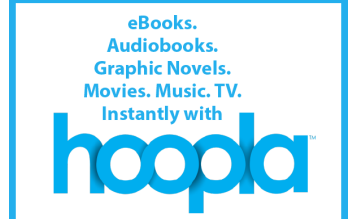
